Adults (anyone over the age of 15) may choose to enter the professional or amateur division. Artists in either division may enter up to 6 works in the show. Professional artists will designate their entries as belonging in one of this year's eight divisions: dimensional art, drawing, oil, acrylic, watercolor, pastel, mixed media or
