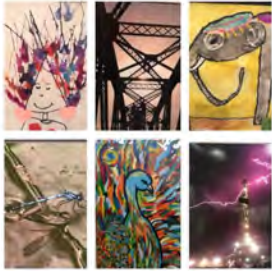
show. So come and join in on the fun.
