


"Looking Forward with BAA"

A Tribute to 50 years of Badland's Art

Artists working in any medium may enter one piece of art representing 50. It may be the number 50, 50 things, a theme of 50 years ago, etc. Accompanying the artwork, **the Artist <u>MUST</u> include a brief description or how the piece represents 50.**

The Tribute category requires an entry form as usual but there is NO entry fee. BAA hopes that deleting the entry fee for this one category will encourage artists to try a new medium or experiment with a new style.
