Old Business:

I. Updates for the 2022 Annual Art Show

We are working on financing and acquiring new standards for the art show. We are making plans in regards to sending out the Call for Entries, retaining judges and are working out details for the show cards and book. We are hoping to have an online entry as an option this year. Elizabeth Henderson will be working as an intern to satisfy her coursework and will be assisting with organization for the show. Now is the time to consider grants and other financing for the show. As the show is in the old White Drug, we are hoping to make use of their storage facilities, but this needs to be arranged.

II. Updates for the Summer Workshop

We have 17 registered; entries are closed now. Continuing Education credits can be signed-up for through the website. The workshop will be at Trinity.

III. Gallery Updates

A. Dickinson State University gallery updates.

1. DSU closes May 13th, then we can start to set-up in the gallery space in Kleinfelter.
2. This is the proposed slate of shows: first show--DSU archives (From the DSU vaults), the second--area artists (Artists of the Prairie), third show (Photography), fourth (BAA Winner's Circle)
3. We would like to have the participating artists volunteer to work. We need to be manning the gallery. We need to find out DSU's summer hours, but we are considering 10-4 or 10-5, four days per week, W-SA, for gallery hours.
4. 6 weeks per show exhibition. Art accepted is at our discretion, considering the audience for the show (family friendly). We would need cards and artist statements for each show's pieces. We would like to do an opening reception for each show.
5. We would like to list the gallery with ND tourism and update the entry for Mind's Eye gallery, listing the handicapped accessibility. We will call it Badlands Art Gallery.

B. Potential Outdoor Art Space

1. Tod and Ruth continue to develop a document that will list our vision, description of proposed features and possible collaborations.

New Business:

I. We are entertaining ideas for a summer outreach activity.

- A. We would like to plan an informal "garage sale art" event. We would like to time it with Roughrider Days, if possible, and locate it in the Downtown area.
