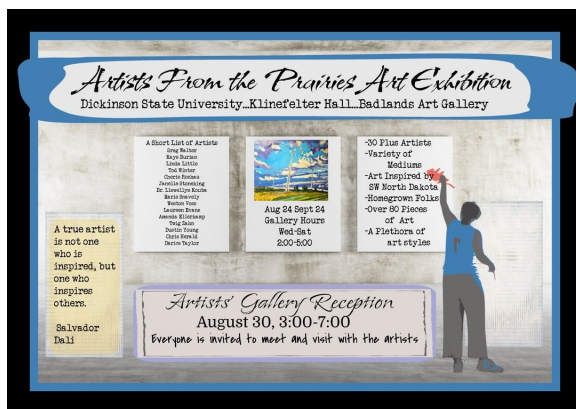

Meeting Minutes: August 3, 2022

Old Business:

- I. Annual Art Show
 - A. White Drug Floor: It is making progress. We will not be replacing any tiles.
 - B. Ribbons: They will be ordered with the addition of some special awards from Women Empowering Women and Connect Medical Clinic.
 - C. Silent Auction: Contact Cherie Roshau or Tod Winter if you are interested in helping in this area of the show.
 - D. Grants and Fundraising
 1. We are checking on the application for the Visitor and Convention Bureau grant.
 - a. Would a billboard fit under their advertising requirements?
 2. Consolidated has grants available.
 3. Tod distributed envelopes and a letter to use to take to businesses for the purposes of fundraising. Let him know if you would like any of these and can help.
 - E. Call for Entry: We are working on this and will send it out ASAP.
 - F. Student Show: Keisha Sparks is available to help with the student portion of the show.
- II. Badlands Art Gallery
 - A. We are working on greater promotion and signage.
 - B. We discussed various sources for volunteers to act as hosts in the gallery when it is open.
 - C. Date change for Artists from the Prairies – August 24th-September 24th.
 1. We need to promote the new show and seek artists.
 2. Drop-off for artist's works has been set for August 11th from 1-7.
 - D. Insurance for liability purposes has been acquired and Ruth will acquire those things necessary to start sales for the new show as well as a donation box.
 - E. It was agreed that door prizes should be given out at the next reception as we did at the first.
 - F. Based on a suggestion, we are considering that it might be a good idea to invite members from the community to lend from their private art collection as a special feature from time to time.
- III. Summer Workshop
 - A. Report on the workshop: It was very helpful to have a workshop nearby to get required CE credits. It was also enjoyable to have an applied art opportunity. Could it be offered for an additional half day so that a full 2 credits could be offered? There was ample time to create, but some found it challenging in regards to endurance.
