

Guidelines

- Artists may submit up to 2 pieces, though only one piece may be selected per artist per cycle.
- The artwork must be ready to hang with sufficient hanging hardware.
- Artwork cannot be larger than 3'x4' framed.
- Depending on the size of the selected works, 3–6 pieces will be chosen for each rotation.
- All artwork must remain on display for the full rotation, even if sold.
- Artwork may be for sale artists will retain 100% of the sale price.
- Artists must provide the title, dimensions, medium, and price (if for sale) with each submission.

We encourage artists working in all styles and mediums to apply. This collaboration is part of our ongoing effort to bring art into public spaces and support the creative community of Williston.
